





That's why we established Club 1882 as part of our strategy to build a stronger, more sustainable development pathway. Spearheaded by Olympic medalist and Cycling Canada board member Curt Harnett, Club 1882 was

launched in 2021 and remains the direct fundraising branch for Cycling Canada's national team development initiatives. All funds raised through Club 1882 are allocated directly to National Team programming, serving developing athletes as they aspire to international success.



CLUB 1882: JUNIOR PROGRAMMING

In recent years, Cycling Canada has made a concerted effort to increase the amount of programming which supports the further development of talented young athletes across all disciplines. Identified as an underfunded area that remains crucial to cultivating future talent, major donors are encouraged to consider focused donations to Junior programming. By supporting Junior programming,

major donors reduce the barrier to entry for major international Junior competitions, ensuring top talent is not limited by financial constraint.
