SOCIAL BEST PRACTICES (ENVE-Appropriate)

REELS (Primary Driver)

Frequency: 4–6 total from camp

Length: 20–40 seconds

Tone: Documentary-light, lo-fi, no forced trends

Best Practices

- Vertical, handheld, imperfect
- Subtitles always
- One idea per reel
- No product callouts unless organic
- Formats that work best
- A → B storytelling (setup → payoff)
- Split-screen comparison
- Voice-over reflections after the ride, not during

STORIES (Personality Layer)

Frequency: Daily during camp

Purpose: Texture + humor

Best Practices

- Short captions
- Polls / sliders
- POV riding clips
- Micro-moments (coffee, banter, kit jokes)

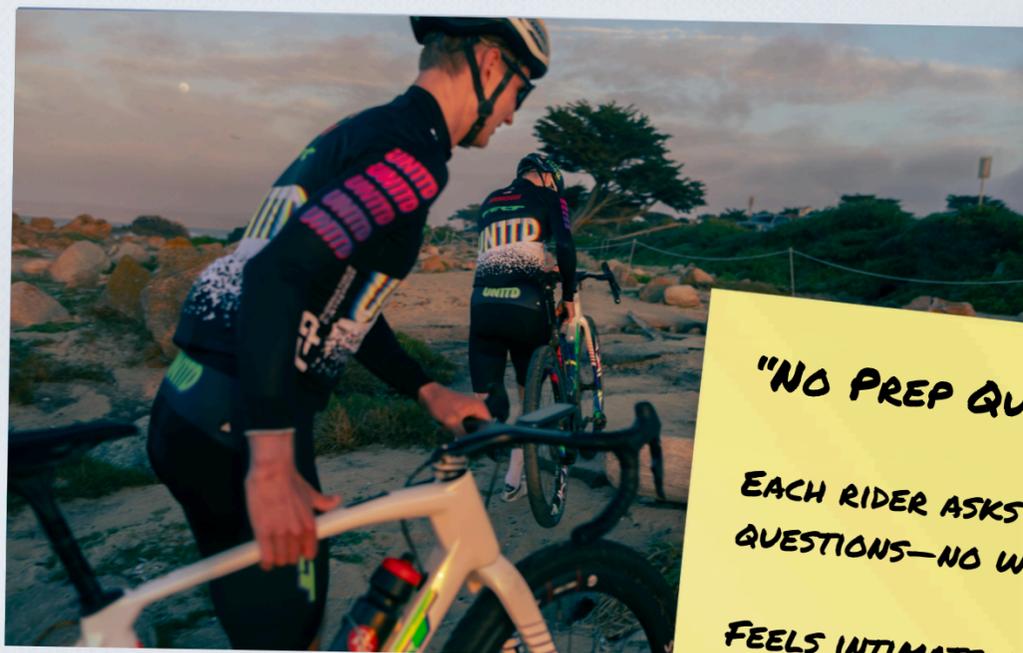
Stories are where ENVE feels present without selling.

STATIC/CAROUSEL (Evergreen)

- 1–2 posts total
- Black & white portraits
- One quote each
- Minimal copy

These become ENVE's timeless assets.

FUN CONTENT IDEAS

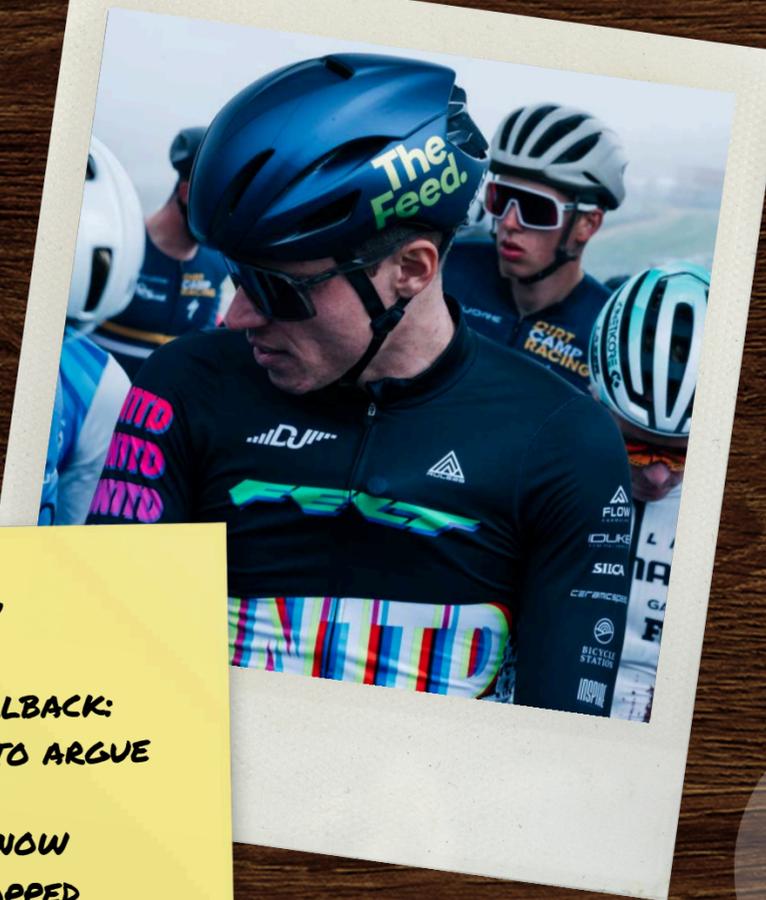


"RIDE DEBRIEF"

POST-RIDE, BREATHLESS REFLECTIONS:

- WHAT WENT WRONG
- WHAT SURPRISED THEM
- WHAT THEY NOTICED ABOUT EACH OTHER

THIS IS WHERE ENVE'S PROCESS-OVER-OUTCOME PHILOSOPHY SHINES.



"THEN VS NOW"

LIGHT ARCHIVAL CALLBACK:

- WHAT WE USED TO ARGUE ABOUT
- WHAT MATTERS NOW
- WHAT WE'VE STOPPED CARING ABOUT

THIS REINFORCES LONGEVITY.

"NO PREP QUESTIONS"

EACH RIDER ASKS THE OTHER 3 QUESTIONS—NO WARNING.

FEELS INTIMATE, NOT BRANDED.

EXAMPLES:

- "WHEN DID YOU THINK I WAS DONE?"
- "WHAT'S ONE THING I OVERTHINK?"
- "WHAT WOULD YOU STEAL FROM MY RACING STYLE?"



"WHO SURVIVES THIS?"

SHORT REEL SERIES:

- WORST WEATHER
- LONGEST CLIMB
- WORST MECHANICAL
- HARDEST RACE MOMENT

QUICK CUTS. HONEST ANSWERS. NO POLISH.

"THE SILENT RIDE"

ONE REEL:

- NO TALKING: JUST BREATHING, WHEELS, DIRT
- TEXT OVERLAY: "SOME PARTNERSHIPS DON'T NEED EXPLAINING."

THIS IS VERY ENVE.

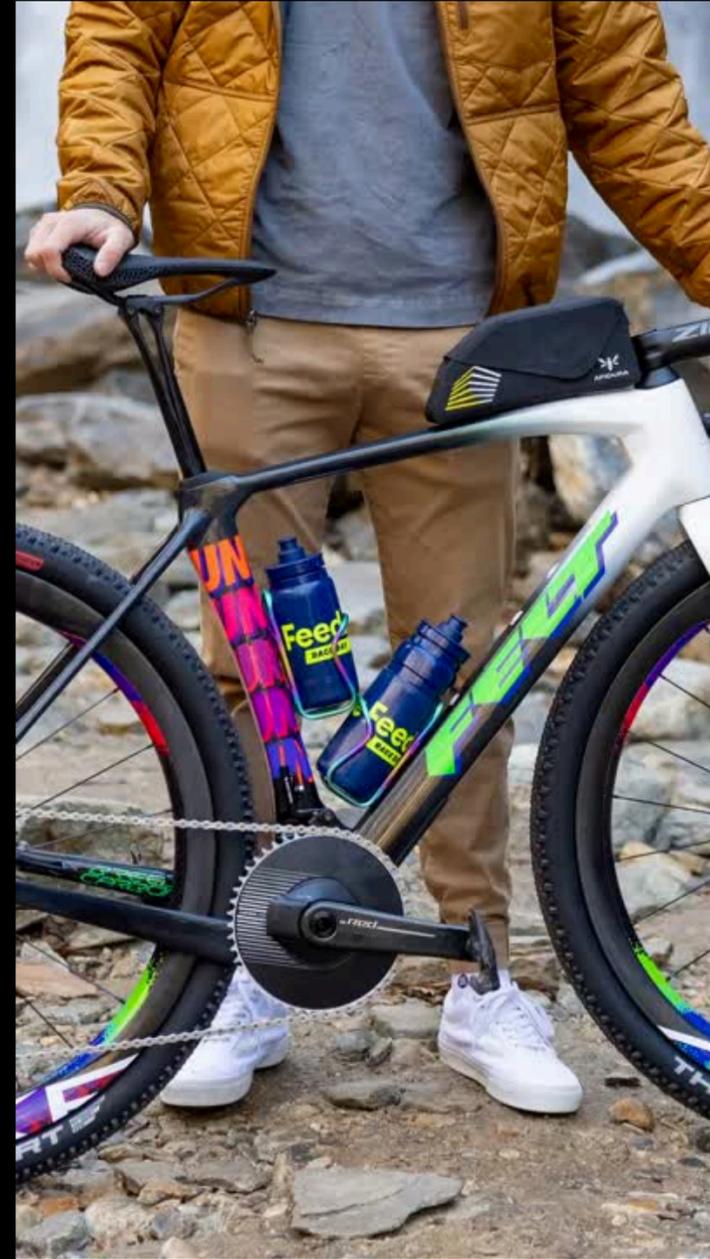
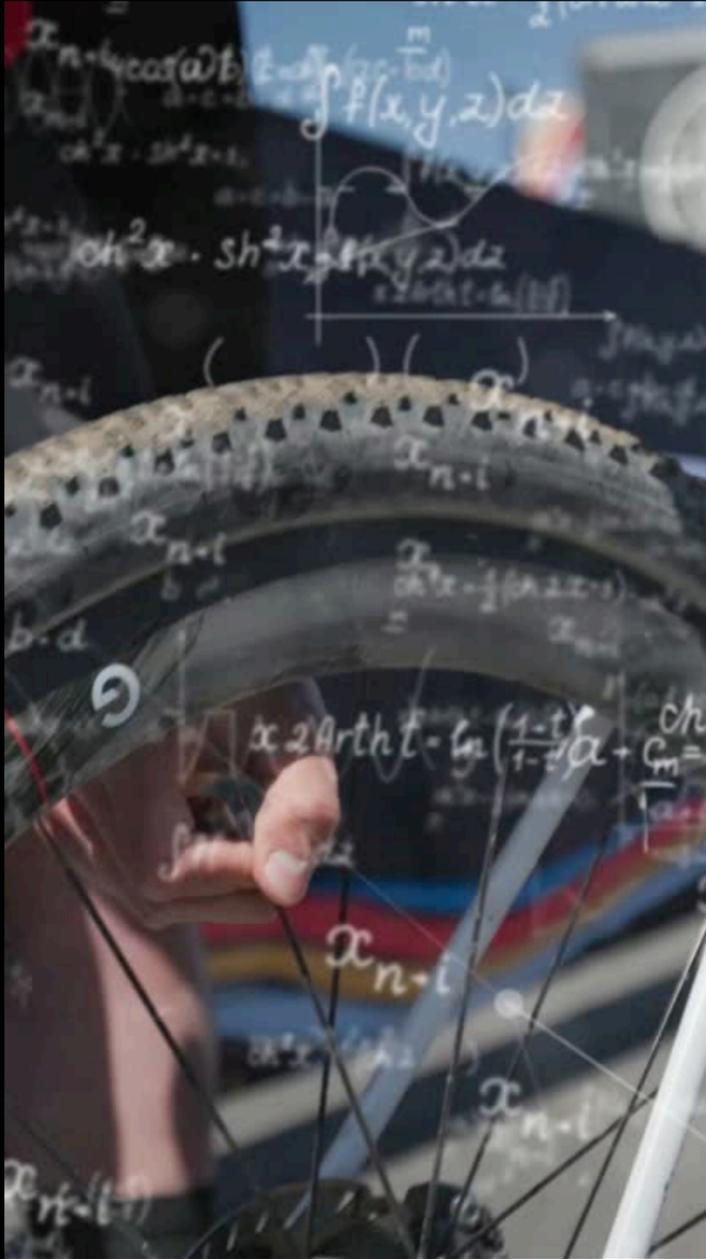
"LIGHT BRAND INTEGRATION"

PRESENCE WITHOUT PRODUCT PUSH:

- HELMET TAP BEFORE A RIDE
- WHEEL SOUND IN SLOW-MO
- FRAME-UP SHOT LEANING BIKES TOGETHER
- END-CARD: "BUILT OVER TIME. @ENVECOMPOSITES"

NO SPECS. NO SELL.
